Work Activities

Week 1 – December 1-8

- I forgot to write down where we worshipped. oops:(
- Cotonou trip. Car Maintenance, battery replacement. Shopping, made arrangements with AGS for moving to Togo. Closed bank account.
- After we returned home the whole family came down with a nasty virus. Stephen and Murphy first and then Matthew then Christine. It knocked us out for four solid days.

- All day Saturday at Church meeting. I taught a lesson from John: Jesus, full of grace and truth. I've taught this lesson a lot, but this was the first time that the majority of the Aja Christians had heard it.

- All-church meeting at Avedjin ended Sunday afternoon.
- Translated Luke 13-19. Had Joseph type in corrections. Joseph and I worked <very> hard for four solid days trying to get Luke finished.
- One-day Cotonou trip to pay AGS.
- One-day trip to Tabligbo to take breakable items.
- Packing.
- Worship with Kindji church. I taught a lesson from Luke 4, Jesus' temptation. They had a special service for us and we enjoyed a good meal together afterwards. It was a very special day that filled our hearts with a lot of joy. The Kindji Christians are very special to us.
